Attendance

Attendance is a big priority for our school this year. It is important that all children attend school every day and on time for a prompt start at 8.45am. The Attendance Officer will be contacting anyone whose attendance falls below 95%.

We encourage children to have excellent attendance and celebrate those that achieve 100% termly and annually. It is important that our children learn the life skills of commitment and punctuality. Attendance and punctuality are monitored carefully by our Attendance Officer in school.

At Woodfield Primary we strive to achieve 100% attendance. Did you know that....

Attending school every day = 100% attendance.

Attending 4 ½ days a week =90% attendance which is 4 weeks missed per year

Attending 4 days a week =80% attendance which is more than half a term missed per year or 2 full years missed over the course of their school career.

Attending 3 ½ days each week =70% attendance which is more than a quarter of the school year missed.

An average attendance of 80% or less across a child's school career adds up to missing a whole 2 years from school

Being late for school reduces learning time.

If your child is 5 minutes late every day they will miss three days of learning each year.

If your child is 15 minutes late every day they will miss is 2 weeks of learning each year.

School starts at 8.45am prompt and finishes at 3.15pm. All absences must be notified by 9am. More details are available in our attendance policy.


Useful Information
