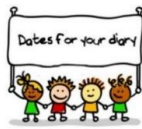
The Coronation of His Majesty The King and Her Majesty The Queen is also a time for celebration across the nation and the Commonwealth, over a weekend of special events:

- **Sunday May 7** a spectacular Coronation Concert will be performed at Windsor Castle with iconic locations across the UK lit up using projections, lasers, drone displays and illuminations.
- **Monday 8 May** a special Bank Holiday has been proclaimed by the Prime Minister in honour of the Coronation, giving everyone the opportunity to join in with their communities and good causes through Big Help Out activities. School is closed.
