Come along to STEM club where we will do many exciting scientific projects together. We will do activities that will involve you designing, making and testing as part of fun and exciting projects! It is an opportunity for lots of practical learning where you can learn lots of new skills whilst being creative and imaginative.

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Tuesday– Spanish for KS1 & KS2 with Mrs Gill – 15 places

Tuesday– Multi-Sports for KS1 & KS2 with Mr Barnett – 15 places

Come along to the sports club every Tuesday to take part in lots of sports, games, and other activities.

Tuesday – Dance for EYFS & KS1 with Miss Jones – 15 places

Come along and join the cheer and dance club! We will be learning different skills and dance routines. We will also play some fun dance games.

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Wednesday – Games for KS1 & KS2 with Ms White – 20 places

Come along to the Crafts and Games club to join in with lots of fun games and activities every week. It will give you a chance to be creative, talk with your friends and challenge yourself!

Wednesday – Funky Fingers for EYFS & KS1 with Miss Clark– 20 places

If you are looking for a calm end to your school day, this is the club for you! Mindfulness is a technique you can learn which involves noticing what is happening in the present moment. We will be doing different activities to help unwind and relax whilst talking to our peers.

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Thursday– Crafts for EYFS & KS1 with Miss McKechnie – 20 places

Join Mrs Miller every Wednesday to discover board games, jigsaw puzzles, card games, and many more! It will give children the chance to socialise with friends and build on team working skills.

Thursday – Ukulele for KS2 with Mr Smith – 20 places

This is an exciting opportunity for children with musical ability to learn to play an instrument. If your child is already showing themselves to have musicality, then this could be the club for them. Ukuleles will be provided but many children go on to purchase their own.

Clubs will need to be paid for in advance and once booked and paid are non-refundable.

Places are limited and will strictly be on a first come first served basis.

We expect good behaviour in all our clubs, including breakfast club, and we will withdraw places, if this is not the case.

Please ensure arrangements are in place to collect your child promptly at the end of the club at **4.15pm** from the main reception or complete the consent form opposite allowing your child to walk home alone. Please note children in FS, Y1, Y2, Y3 & Y4 will not be allowed to walk home alone they must be collected.

However, we strongly advise that all children are collected from clubs.

For all clubs please complete the slip opposite and return it to main reception. If you are allocated a place in a club, you will get a text notification confirming the details – YOU SHOULD THEN MAKE PAYMENT IN FULL FOR THE WHOLE TERM ON PARENTPAY – WE NO LONGER ACCEPT CASH AT THE OFFICE.
