What is Gooseberry Planet?

Gooseberry Planet supports learning about online safety in a unique way, by joining the student, teacher and parent together. The student uses our online game (App) and the concept of gamification, as part of structured learning programme. There is a total of 3 Apps which can be accessed via a desktop. Gooseberry Student for the child, Gooseberry Teacher and Gooseberry Parent.

How do you educate children and young people to build knowledge, skills and capability when it comes to online safety?

Your child will be playing as a character called Taff, who faces real life scenarios that they might expect to encounter online. Learning takes place through problem solving, consequence and reward for positive choices and online behaviours. The game includes different levels and scenarios that are designed to be flexible and adaptable, depending upon the learning needs of the children and provides digital literacy opportunities for all children. A workbook sits alongside the game for the children to record their learning and progress within school.

As a parent you can now be part of their learning journey. Gooseberry Parent allows you, to see how your child is responding within the game to each scenario. The platform will give you an overview of every answer and as a school we will then support and guide you through the right conversations. Look out for online Parent Workshops, which will be promoted through our school website.

The resource area is full of tips and advice for parents and carers to support you in being part of your child's learning journey. Please download the app from any of the app stores. As a school, we will provide you with your child's username. If your child has been set the games as homework, please download the Gooseberry Student App onto any devices via the app store on your device.
